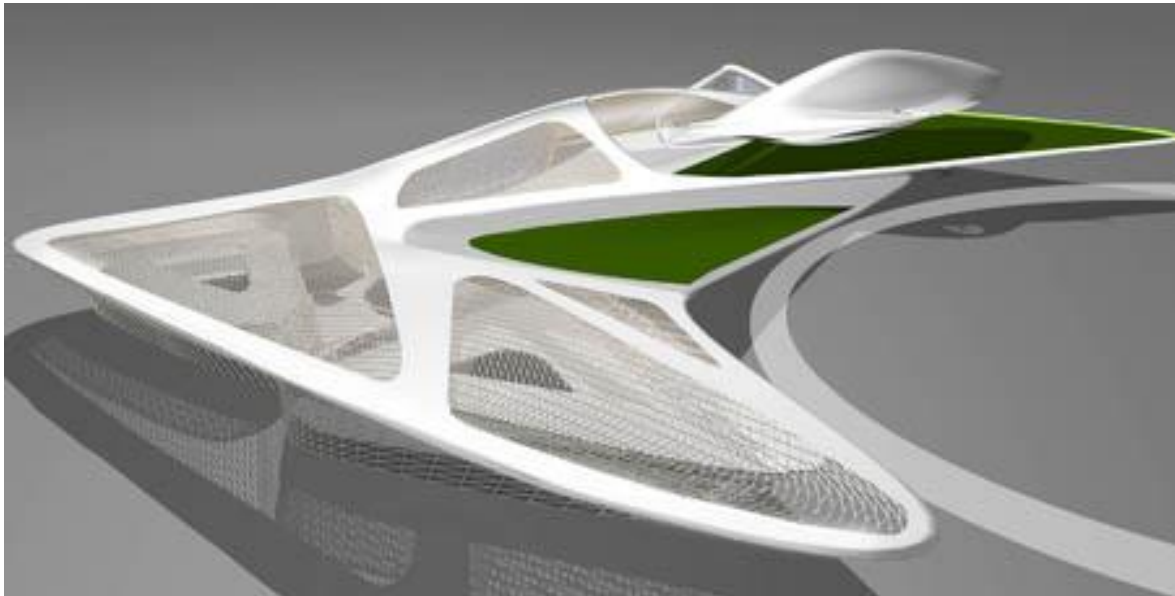


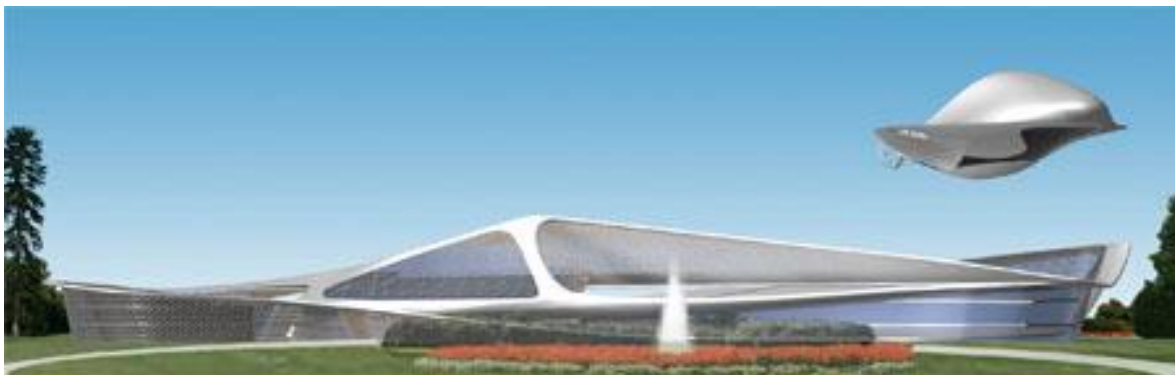
Rediscovery - Presidential airship concept

This airship concept, designed by Alex Schulz, is intended for use by the President and staff members as the mobile part of a re-imagined, modern White House, which includes an airship landing pad. The airship includes workspaces, accommodations, communication systems and other features needed to support their daily activities. This design concept was developed as a submission to the 2009 “WHITEHOUSEREDUX” competition.



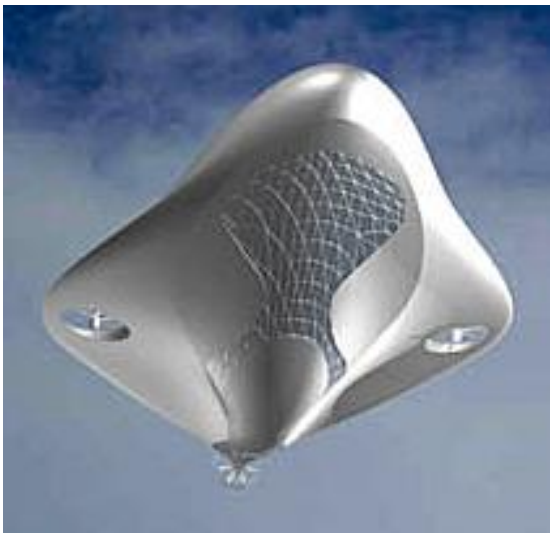
The Rediscovery airship on a landing pad (upper right) at the re-imagined White House.

The renderings depict an airship that is capable of vertical takeoff and landing (VTOL) and hovering. This feature would be useful for a Presidential delegation visiting a disaster site in need of federal emergency response support.

As a symbol, the Rediscovery airship was intended to promote a worldwide exchange of “new regenerative technologies,” as embodied in the zero-emissions airship used by the US President.
