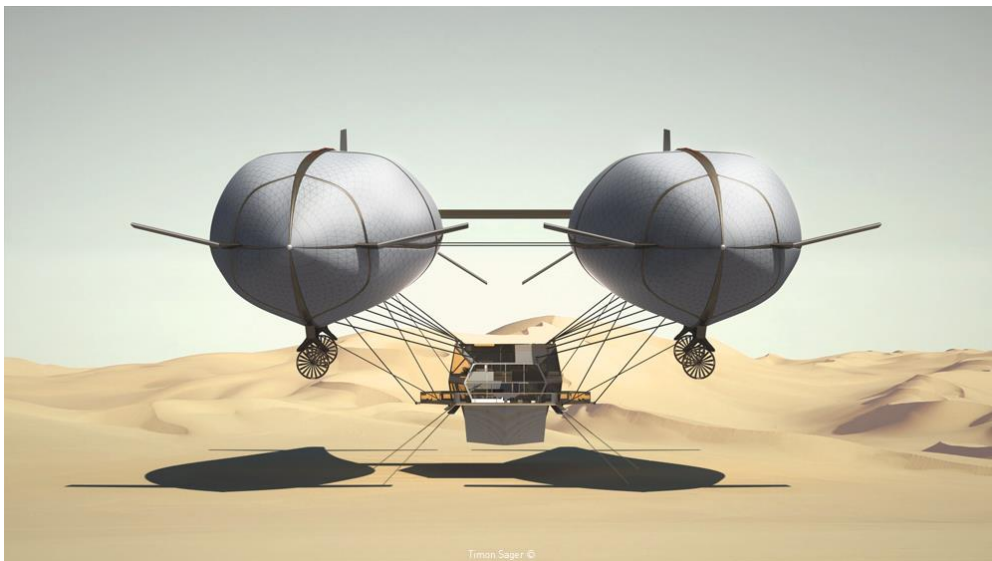


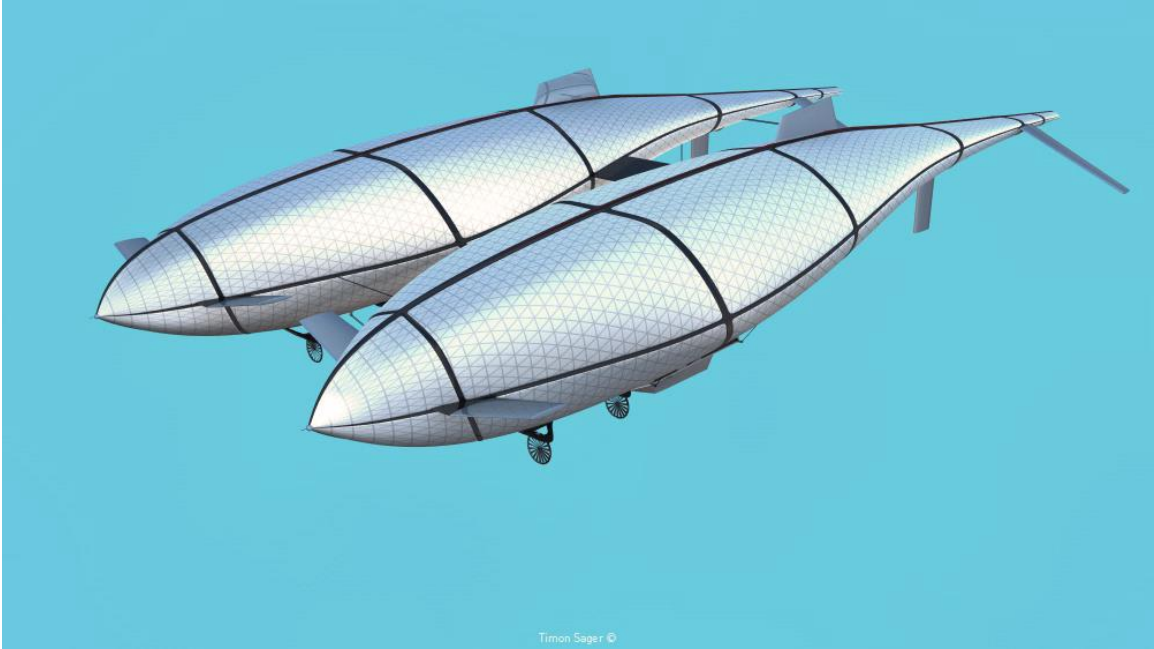
Wolke7: flying house concept

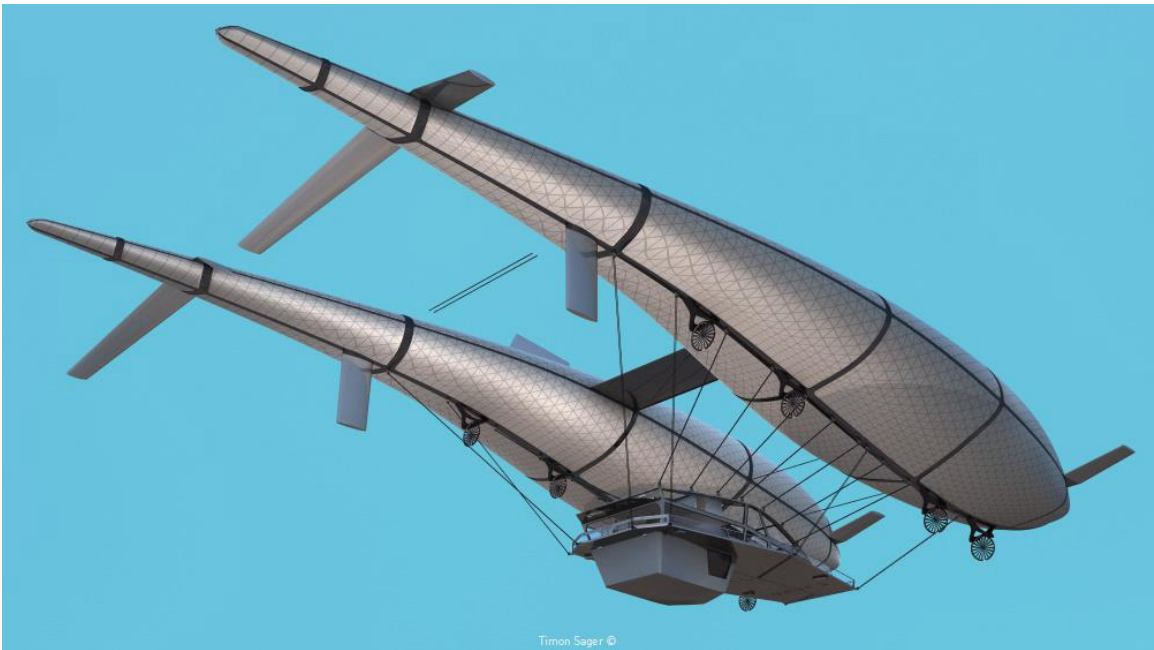
Swiss designer Timon Sager developed his 2012 design concept for this sleek, twin-hull, futuristic (in a Mad Max sort of way) airship house with multiple decks, modern accommodations and plenty of clear glass windows and outdoor decks for enjoying the vistas while floating among the clouds or cruising in scenic locations. The two hulls are held apart by rigid structures. Propulsion is provided by four small propulsors under the centerline of each hull.





The passenger “gondola” (the house) is suspended between the two airship hulls.
