

Aeros - Neona sky yacht airship

Aeros has developed a design concept for a modest-sized lenticular (flying saucer-shaped) airship named Neona, which is intended for use as a personal sky yacht. Aeros describes the Neona as follows:

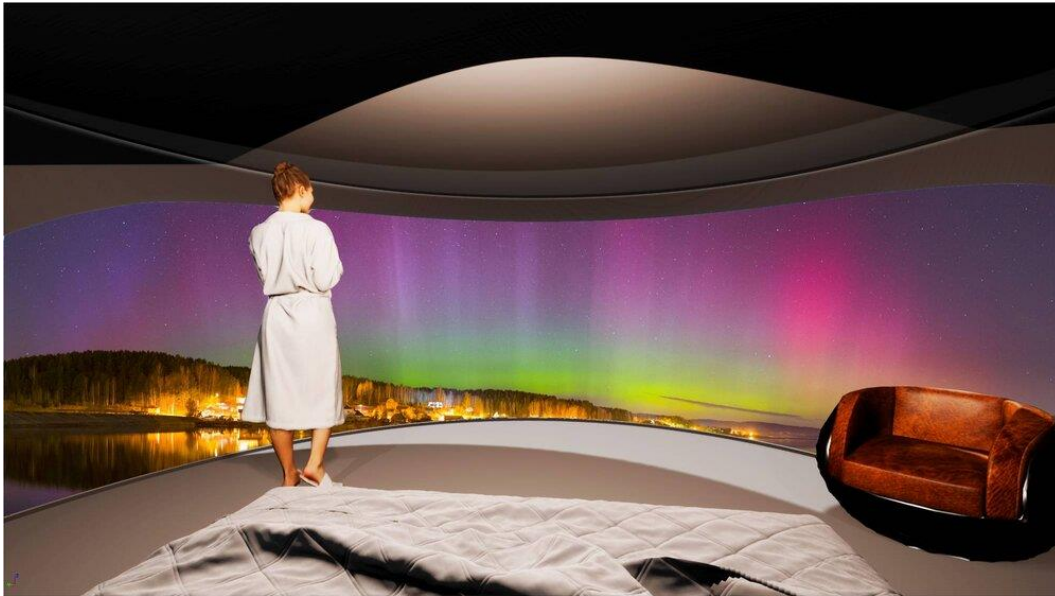
“Inspired by Aeros experience designing commercial cargo ships where the emphasis is on fuel efficiency and utility, this forward-looking aircraft maintains these ideals while putting the passenger experience in the forefront. Neona airship is an innovation in luxury travel and VVIP tour experiences. This flying yacht has a hugely flexible structure that offers optimum distribution of both private and communal spaces to achieve the perfect aircraft for the discerning traveler looking for something new. It looks like a UFO, it is a luxury yacht in the sky, and it flies like a dream.”
