The team of Elie Ahovi, Jérémie Levain, François Mahieu, Marc Tran, Valentin Delrue, and Nicolas Lenotte designed this futuristic large airship in 2012. The airship is intended to travel around big cities and other places to respond to human needs, for example assisting the Red Cross. The general shape is reminiscent of the whale-shaped "Manned Cloud" flying hotel concept developed by French industrial designer Jean-Marie Massaud in 2005.
